Luke just drops this amazing functions of a prophet who shares about an upcoming disaster and allowed for believers to prepare for it by sending aid ahead of time. This is what we are missing today! Our prophets voice, both proclaiming and forth-telling of what God is up. If we would listen, we might be able to get ahead of crisis and prepare/help the church instead of trying to rally afterward. This office, of prophet, only works in cases where the body is unified and in agreement. Can you imagine someone using that gift today? There is so little trust, because the prophets are not known, accountable and submissive to a body or THE body. Then there would be an all out attack on what denomination or tribe the prophet belongs to. However, it is still lacking today. Maybe it happens and the denomination leadership don't know or don't pass on the information?
