I love Paul's ability to synthesize all of Judaic culture and practices into simple Greek concepts that have a way of living beyond time and cultural boundaries. They reach me! I'm sure this idea of living in a non-God-aware world was all through the Old Testament when God was speaking to Israel and desired to speak through Israel. This is just simple humanity 101 - be nice, be kind, be ATTRACTIVE. Especially in attitude and conversation. This could be translated several ways: be normal, sensitive, aware. People can smell weird or odd, and now with the advancement of knowledge, news and social media, they can smell a catch, a trap, a sale or a con. Everyone's "radar" is up and aware of "I'm being nice" angle because I want something from you. Is is so hard just to NOT want something from someone. Is it too hard just to be nice, be encouraging, smile and use someone's name in the conversation? I think we can all manage this! Let God do the hard job of convincing, wooing, and working where we can't anyways in people's heart. Leave the heavy work up to God.
