Maybe it only takes one respected leader to calm the violent lizards of humanity? I can think of a few throughout history. Gamaliel's point remains as the basis for decisions in church discipline still today. If it is from God, you will not be able to stop them AND you may just be fighting AGAINST God himself. Case in point, most of the reformations and revivals could have used a Gamaliel moment, don't you think?
